

Fort Hays State University Dual Degree Master Program

Article 1 – Education Program Definition

1+1, Dual-Degree; MLS, Global Studies (FHSU); MA, International Affairs (Wenzao)

Students will study one year at Wenzao and one year at FHSU. Upon completion of the program, students will earn degrees from both FHSU and Wenzao.

Article 3 – Recruitment and Admissions Criteria

Wenzao will recruit students for this 1+1 program.

Students must meet the admission criteria for both FHSU and Wenzao.

Before starting the FHSU classes, students must have at least a 3.0 GPA (on a 4-point scale) in all coursework completed at Wenzao, and pass an English proficiency exam with a minimum score of 79-TOEFL (internet- based), or 6.5-IELTS. All relevant documents required for admission to FHSU should be submitted by October 15th if applying for spring semester admission, or submitted by June 1st if applying for fall semester admission.

Wenzao will submit to FHSU transcripts (in the English language) for all students.

Article 4 – Immigration Requirements

In addition to the documents required for admission, students must also submit the documents required for obtaining a student visa for entry into and study in the United States of America.

- Financial Form and Bank Certification – Must indicate that student has sufficient funds to cover expenses for the entire year of study at FHSU. Complete the FHSU financial form or provide a letter of financial support signed by your sponsor. Downloadable:

- Passport I.D. page – Copy of I.D. page that includes passport number, picture, name, date of birth, sex, place of birth, date issued, and the expiration date.

Article 5 – Financial Requirements

For all courses in the first year taught by Wenzao, students will pay tuition fees directly to Wenzao.

For all courses in the second year taught by FHSU, students will pay tuition fees

directly to FHSU.

- Tuition— Students will pay the non-resident graduate tuition and fee rate,
